

## 1 COMMUNITY GRANTS POLICY AND PROPOSED GRANTS FRAMEWORK – FURTHER REPORT

That Council note the report by the Sport and Community Development Coordinator and the Manager of Community Services to the Infrastructure and Services Committee Meeting dated 25 March 2014 and the further report to the General Committee Meeting dated 31 March 2014 and:

- A. Repeal the Community Grants Policy that transferred to the Noosa Council from the Sunshine Coast Regional Council under the *Local Government (De-amalgamation Implementation) Regulation*;
- B. Adopt the Community Grants Policy (Attachment 1 to the General Committee report);
- C. Adopt the proposed amended grants framework and criteria (Attachment 2 - as tabled at the General Committee Meeting); and
- D. Delegate to the CEO the development of operational requirements for the application and distribution of community grants to ensure compliance with the adopted Policy and relevant legislative requirements.

## 2 KIN KIN QUARRY BACKGROUND

That Council note the report by Coordinator, Development Assessment to the Planning & Organisation Committee dated 25 March 2014 on the Kin Kin Quarry background and:

- A. Note that Council officers will actively monitor the quarry operations to ensure the conditions of the development approval are met, noting that the Department of Environment and Heritage Protection are the administering authority for environmental matters;
- B. Write to the Department of Environment and Heritage Protection and seek their confirmation that the Department's officers will actively monitor the quarry's operations for compliance with the conditions of the Environmentally Relevant Activity Permit;
- C. Write to the Department of Transport and Main Roads and advise them of the Council and community's concerns that Kin Kin Pomona Road is not of an appropriate standard and design to cater for additional quarry trucks;
- D. Note the Sunshine Coast Regional Council resolution of 19 September 2013 and confirm that Noosa Council will set load limits and use restrictions on its local roads via section 6 of Local Law Number 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities, Infrastructure and Roads) 2011 should the quarry operations adversely impact on the safety and standard of local roads in the area; and
- E. Authorise the Chief Executive Officer to seek legal opinion regarding Council's ability to determine an annual capacity limit on the Kin Kin Quarry in light of the Noosa Council motion of 27<sup>th</sup> November 2003, and more specifically, Judge Dodds' judgement of the P&E Court in December 2010.
